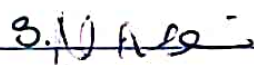
Women's Day

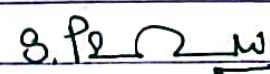

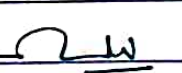

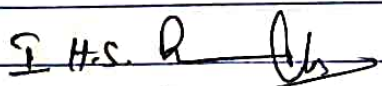

2.30 PM - Reached the Beach

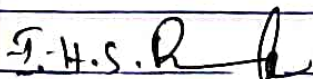

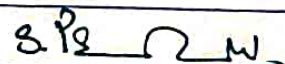
